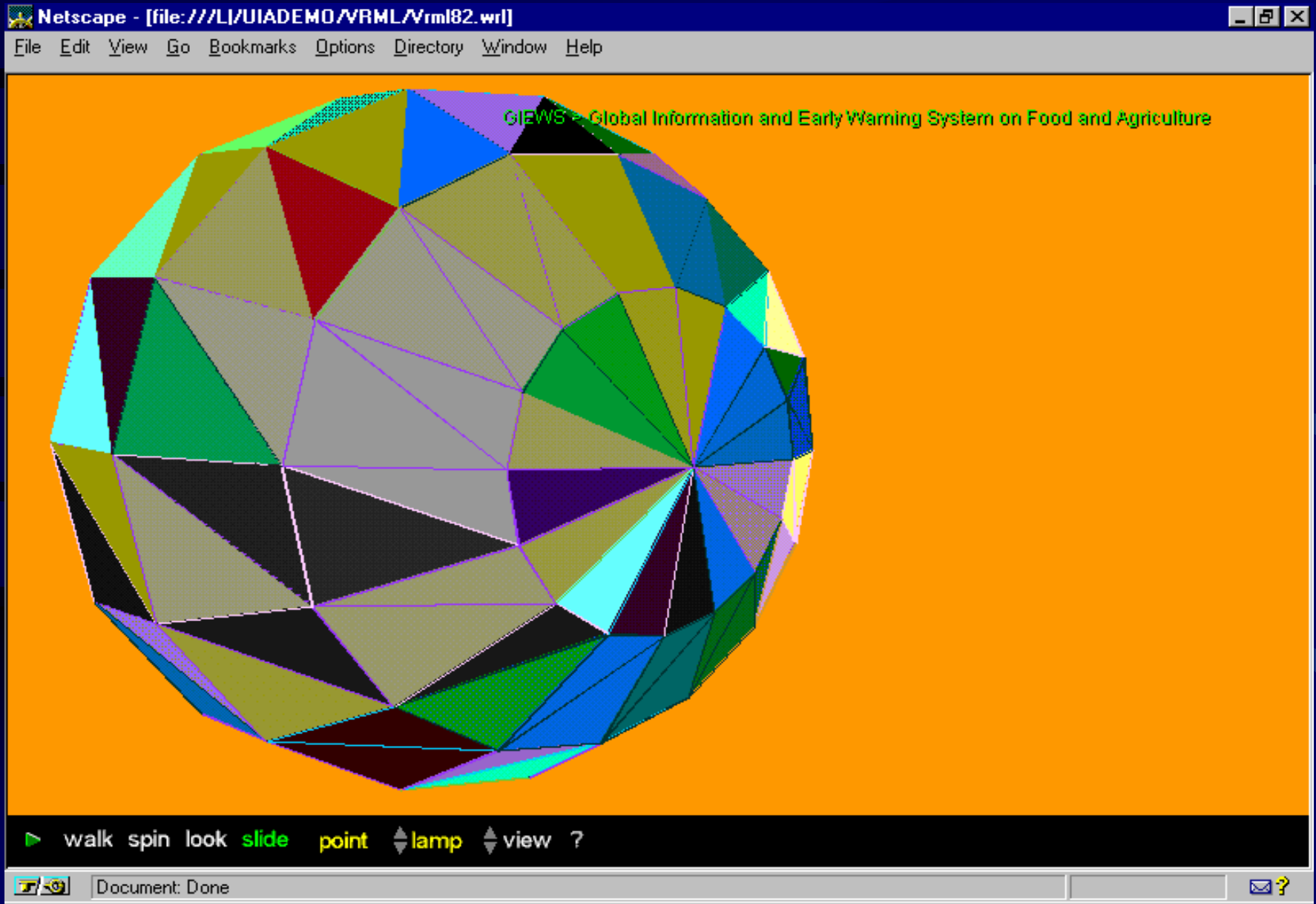


# VRML Example 1: World problem loop interlocks

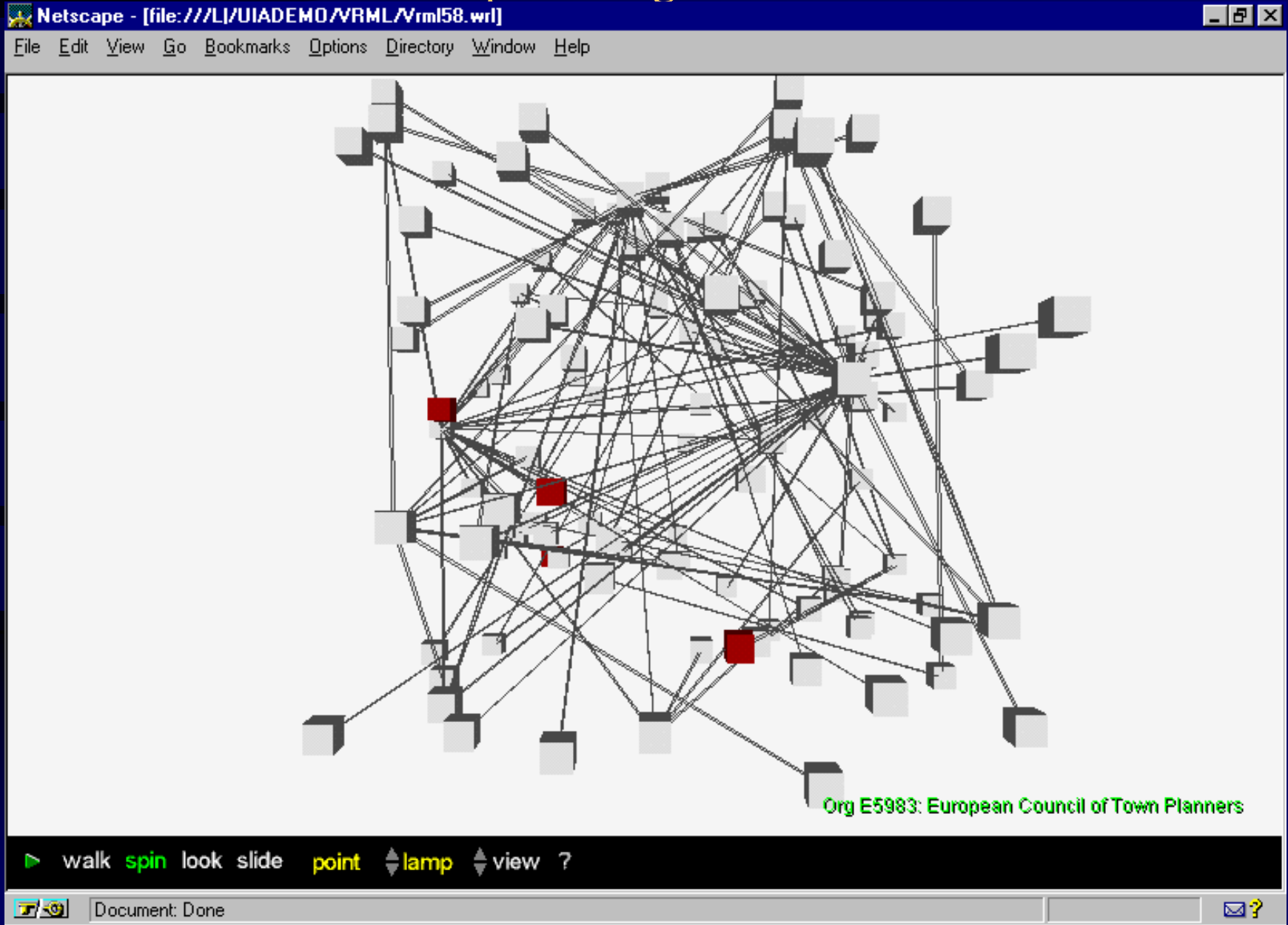




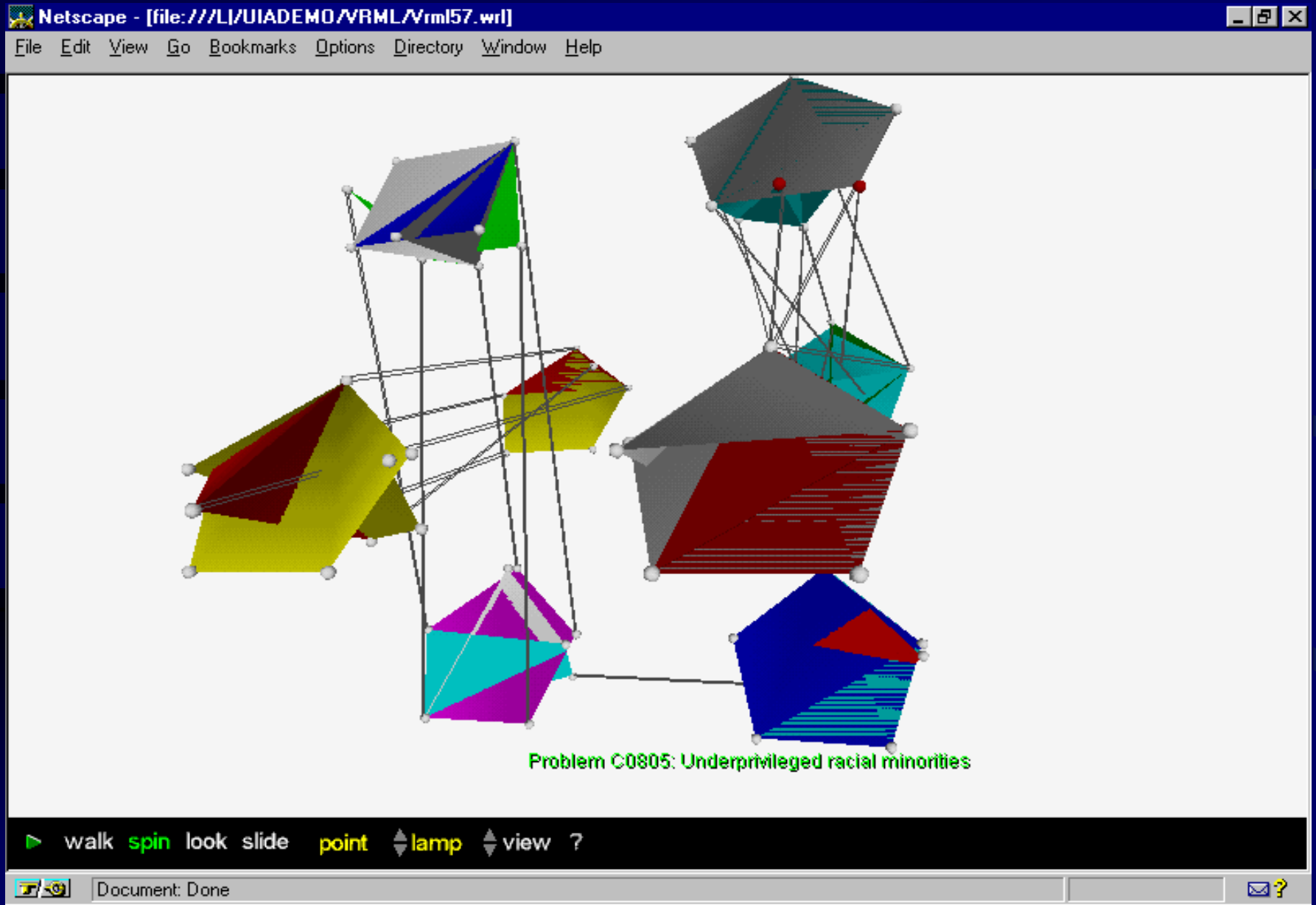
# VRML Example 5a: Organizations - sphere (EU system)



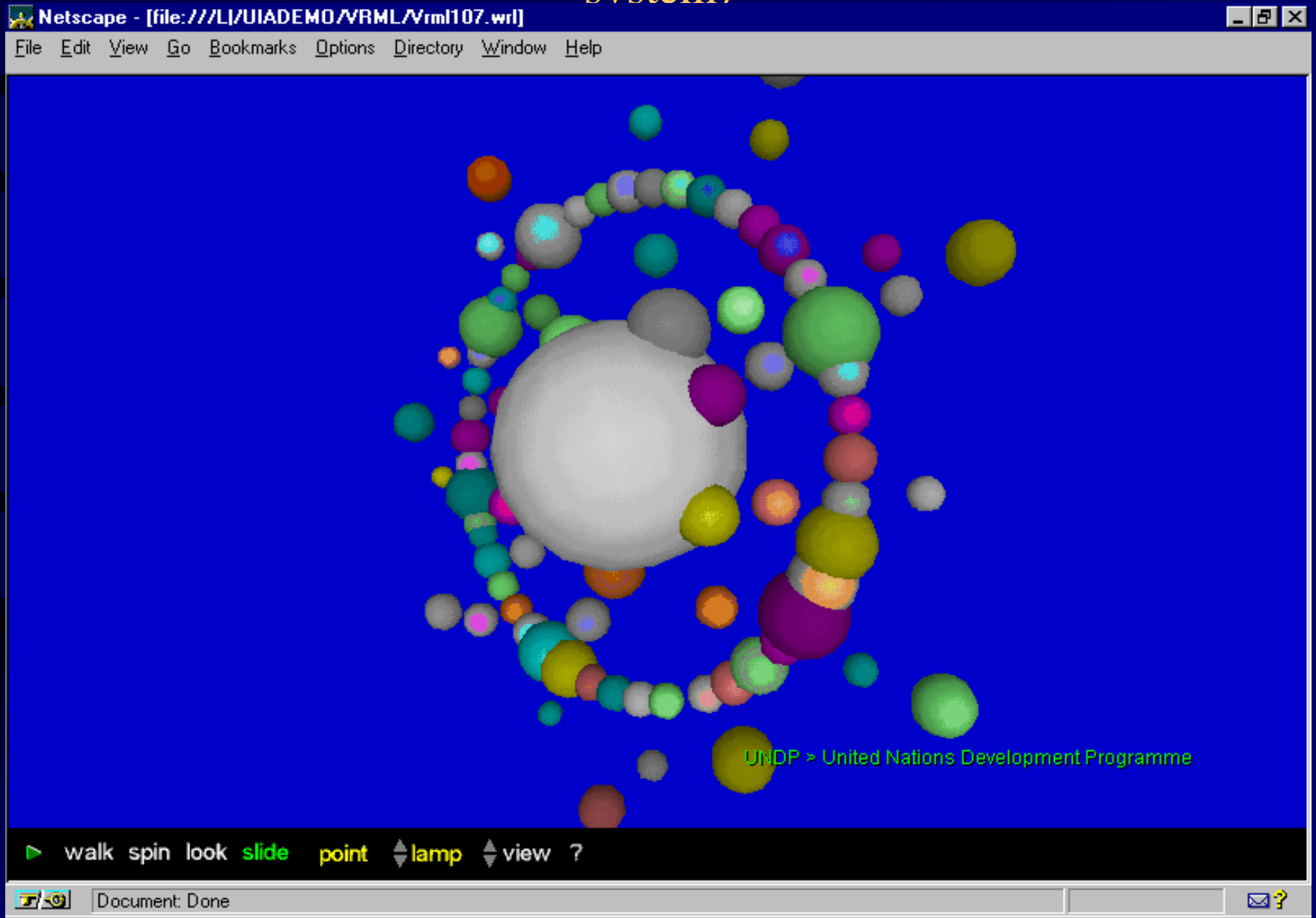

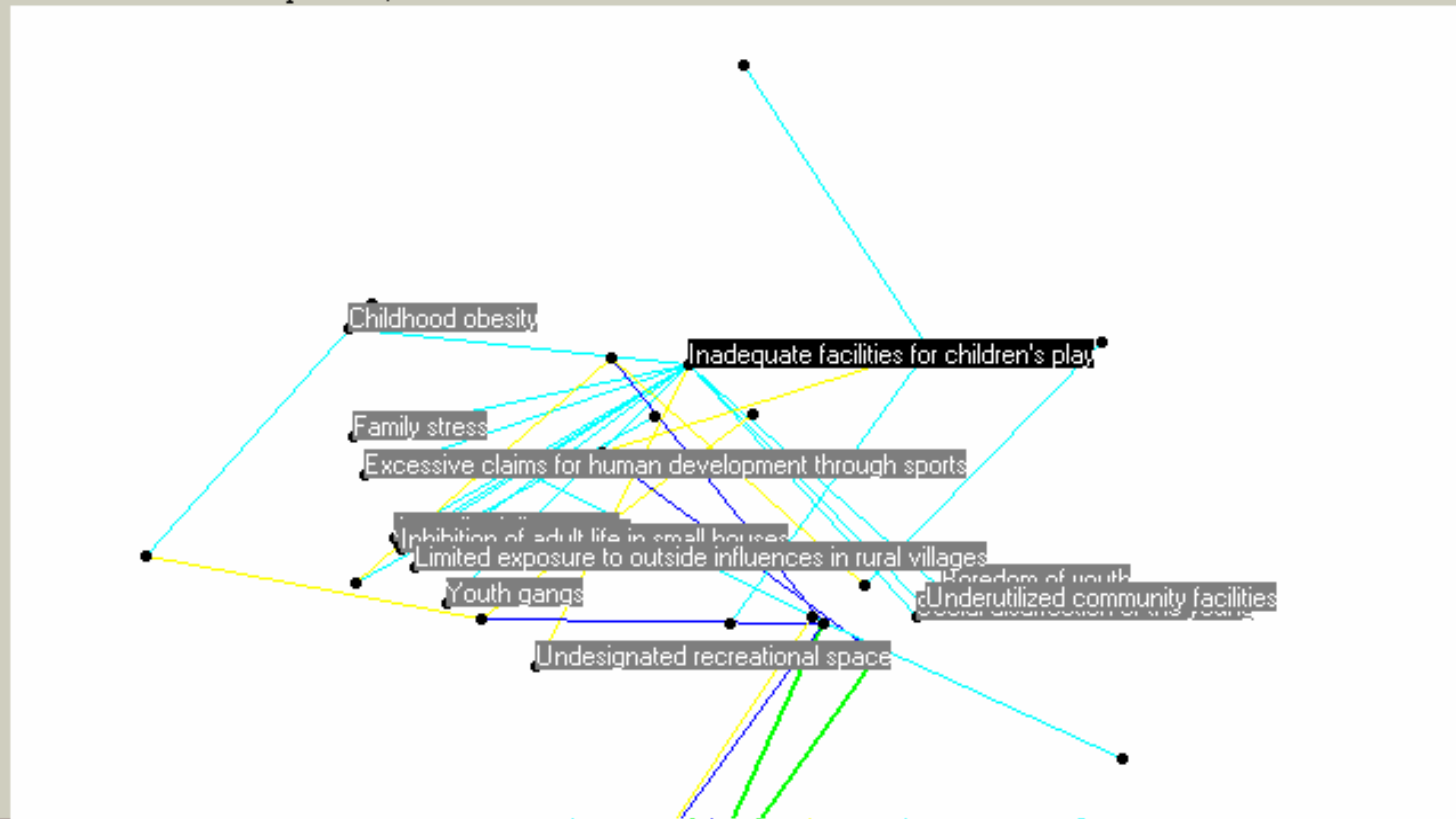
